



# **History**

- TB considered occupational disease for postal workers given the conditions they worked under.
- Sanatoria Fund established in Ireland in 1906.
- In 2001 name of the fund changed to Medisan.
- 2022 Medisan achieved charitable status.
- Membership (2024)
  - An Post 4,308eir 719
  - Others 22
- Donations of €50k across multiple charities

### **CWU Social Benefit Fund**

#### Social Benefit Fund

- Payment calculated using flat weekly rate.
- €120/week for full-time (37.5hrs)
- €80/week for part-time (23-30hrs)
- €40/week for part-time (less than 23hrs)
- · Payment for 12 months
- · Provision to apply to NEC for extension

#### Medisan

Financial Assistance during periods of reduced pay

- 70% of basic pay to max of€850 per month
- Max €10k

**Consultation and Drug-** Assistance of €200 per quarter (less company payment).

**Treatment Centres** 50-75% payment to approved treatment centres (prior approval).

**Specific cases of Cardiac surgery** waiting list – consideration of payment to cost of treatment, including mtce costs, to max grant of 80% of total costs. (not exceed €5k.)

**Public Hospital charges** – daily inpatient charges, outpatient charges, Voluntary health insurance shortfall – 80% of shortfall to a max of €5k for specific Cardiac surgery. 50% match up of Private Insurance up to a maximum €5k.

Note all above applies to qualifying illnesses – must be a member for 6 months to apply.

*Medisan Qualifying illnesses* - TB, Psychiatric illness, Cardiac Disease, Insulin- dependent Diabetes, Diseases of the Central Nervous System, Cancer and Addictions.
